



Home Builders Care Foundation 2024 Impact

- **(14) Construction Projects Completed** for shelter-related nonprofits - all providing supportive housing solutions and help to families in need.
- **Over 1,645 individuals / family members were sheltered annually** at our project sites. Thousands more were provided additional means of support by our **28 nonprofit partners** this year.
- Our charitable efforts helped maintain **223 supportive shelter bed units**, including the creation of **14 new bed units**. By providing well-functioning and safe living environments that promote stability and dignity, we help safeguard and strengthen our communities.
- This year, **we invested close to \$500,000 into the Maryland community** to help the homeless, victims of domestic violence, the disabled, low-income seniors, persons in recovery and families needing special care - all in partnership with our nonprofit partners.



Some of our notable projects include:

The construction of a new Pediatric Respite Home with the *Believe in Tomorrow Children's Foundation* is our Marquee Project for 2024. The **Children's House by the Sea II** is adjacent to Believe's existing flagship property and offers two new townhomes that can accommodate larger families of critically ill children with short life expectancies. Each unit includes an attached efficiency to offer space for either a traveling nurse or grandparents. The completed facility in early 2025 will provide a relaxing and carefree retreat from the stresses of a serious illness. **EASTERN SHORE**

Extensive interior and exterior improvements were made at the **Veterans Safe Haven Shelter**, a 10-bed emergency housing program of the *Montgomery County Coalition for the Homeless*. The backyard was transformed with the removal of a large invasive tree, fence repairs, new plantings and a patio complete with new outdoor furniture and a grill. Inside, a fresh coat of paint, new bedroom and bathroom doors, plus an updated kitchen will help provide the men a warm welcome as they begin their journeys towards stability. **MONTGOMERY COUNTY**

A 1000 sq. ft. addition at a **Maternity Home for Homeless Pregnant Women** received a boost from the Foundation to help move it towards completion. Part of the *Gabriel Network*, the home's extension will make room for a new client bedroom, improved counseling space and storage, as well as a separate private quarter for the program's live-in case manager, an essential part of the Gabriel Network's support program. **PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY**

Additional projects included providing new appliances at a home away from home for cancer patients in **Baltimore City**, building a safe new entrance at an apartment for a disabled adult in **Charles County**, installing over 4000 sq. ft. of new flooring at a 57 unit apartment complex for formerly homeless families in **Montgomery** and constructing new security fencing for low-income seniors in **Frederick**.
